

## STASH SALE INFORMATION

The committee will accept fiber related items at the October guild meeting on October 11, or on Friday, October 13 from 4 pm to 8 pm at the Clubhouse at Murray Oaks.

At the September and October guild meetings we will have labels ready for you to put on your items.

This sale is open for anyone to purchase items, however, only current guild members can submit items to be sold. *Guild memberships must be purchased or renewed before the sale in order to submit items for sale. We will not accept any membership registrations at the sale.*

The committee running the sale reserves the right to reject any item as not qualified.

### Here are the guidelines for the yarn swap:

When you drop off your sale items:

- ◆ Yarn, knitting accessories, books, patterns, etc. can be sold but all must be in sealable clear bags and marked clearly.
- ◆ You will be assigned a 3-letter ID, given a Master Sheet and a label for each bag. Label each bag with your ID number, bag number (start with #1) and sale price of the bag. The bag number and sale price must match with the bag number and sale price on your master list. Do not put your name on the bag. Number additional bags consecutively.
- ◆ On the Master List, write a brief description of the contents of each sealed clear plastic bag, the bag number and the sale price of the bag. If possible, please email a second copy of the master list to Jan Brittain at ([jbrittai@comcast.net](mailto:jbrittai@comcast.net)) before the sale. When you are assigned your ID number, you will need to add that to your master list and each sale bag. Do not put your name on the bag. BE SURE YOUR NAME IS ON YOUR MASTER LIST.
- ◆ Please use whole dollars for price. The committee will not have silver change.
- ◆ Mark yarn for sale with a price, or note if it is "free".
- ◆ Yarn must be clean and odor-free. If possible, include ball bands for yarn, or needle size if you are selling needles, or other identifying information that the buyer will want to know.
- ◆ Yarn does not have to be in a full skein.
- ◆ Only guild members may offer yarn for sale or trade. If you are unable to attend, you may send in your goodies with a fellow guild member.
- ◆ Anyone interested in some bargain yarn may come – friends, neighbors, relatives, etc. Please spread the word!
- ◆ Credit Cards (Visa/MasterCard) will be accepted, also cash or checks (payable to Salt Lake Knitting Guild).

The Salt Lake Knitting Guild will deduct a fee of 25% of the sale price, as voted on at the May Meeting. The remaining 75% of the sale price will be disbursed to you at the November meeting. If you will not be at the November meeting, or would like your disbursement sooner, please include a SASE with your master list when you drop off your yarn.

Items left after the sale will be available to be picked up at Susan Lewin's home. Times for the pick up at Susan's house are available from Oct 15-22 by appointment.
