# Class Descriptions for Romi Hill Workshops Westminster College, Salt Lake City March 17-18, 2018

### Lacehacker Advanced Beginner to Advanced

Saturday March 17 9 am-12 pm

Romi teaches you her favorite lace tips and tricks in this hands-on class. Learn about materials for lace knitting, the best cast-ons and bind-offs, tricks for keeping edges loose when switching colors, managing charts, avoiding errors, using markers, managing beads, and many other tips to make your lace life easier. If you have a tip you want to share or a question: bring it on! The more the merrier.



Materials: Fingering-weight to aran-weight yarn (tip: bring light-colored yarn that doesn't split). You should have a range of needle sizes to try that are appropriate for the yarn, making sure to bring needles in larger sizes than yarn ball band states. Smooth cotton waste yarn (fingering or sport weight) and a crochet hook in a size appropriate for the waste yarn.

## Reciprocate/Mosaic Knitting Intermediate

#### Saturday March 17, 2-5 pm

A lovely shawl using the mosaic knitting slipped stitch technique to accomplish colorwork (only one color is worked at a time). Reciprocate is based on a traditional German shawl shape. This is a great introduction to using color to pattern your knits! We will be working a miniature version of the shawl (full sized version not included).

*Materials*: US size 4 knitting needles, two colors of fingering weight yarn - 130 yards apiece

# Lace Surgery

### Intermediate to advanced. Must be able to read charts.

In this workshop, not only will we discuss techniques to avoid mishaps, participants will learn how to rip a section of lace back and knit it up row by row without having to rip the entire project out.

Students will be given charted knitting homework to be prepared prior to the class: 2 lace swatches with mistakes to be operated upon during class!

*Materials*: swatches, double pointed knitting needles at least 2 sizes smaller than used to knit swatch, crochet hook in similar size to dpns, small foam core sheet (or something else to which the swatch can be pinned), t pins, point protectors, patience.




### Shapely Shawls Intermediate

Sunday March 18, 2-5 pm

Learn about different shapes that shawls can come in! Wed go through several ways to shape shawls and how you can expect to increase or decrease to arrive at a particular shape. Then we will cast on for a small shawl made with sock yarn.

Materials: knitting needles in size depending on pattern, shawl pattern, sock or other yarn for shawl. Note that class fee does not include pattern. Patterns not included and must be purchased by students.
